



## SUPPLIES:

- Stamp Set: Autumn Harvest
- Paper: Watercolor Paper, Old Olive, Cast-A-Spell Designer Series Paper
- Ink: Basic Brown Classic
- Accessories: Really Rust, Old Olive, Pumpkin Pie, Ruby Red Classic Reinkers, Old Olive Grosgrain Ribbon, Paper Snips, Bone Folder, Aqua Painter
- Technique: Masking

## CARD DIRECTIONS:

1. Base card or Layer 1: Cut Old Olive card stock to 4 ¼" x 11" and fold in half using a bone folder for a sharp crease.
2. Layer 2: Cut Cast-A-Spell DSP to 4 ½" x 5 3/8" and punch with the Double Rectangle Punch about ¼" from the right side (see photo for placement). This is for the ribbon.
3. Layer 4: Cut Old Olive card stock to 4 1/8" x 3 3/8" and set aside
4. Layer 5: Cut watercolor paper to 4" x 3 5/8".
5. Stamp image using Basic Brown.
  - a. Stamp leaves twice – first time on watercolor paper. Second time on post it note.
  - b. Cut out leaves from post it note
  - c. Mask leaves and stamp the two small pumpkins on watercolor paper and then on post it note.
  - d. Cut out small pumpkins from post it note
  - e. Mask small pumpkins and stamp large pumpkin
6. Color in images using the reinkers (see supply list)
7. After images are dry, you need to trim the bottom of the layer 5 (watercolor paper) so that it measures 4" x 3 ¼". Carefully trim around leave (see photo)
8. Insert ribbon through the rectangle punches on DSP and tie knot (see photo for placement.
9. Assemble all the layers.
10. You're done!
