

Inspired by Nature – July 2009



Supplied Needed:

- Stamp Set: Inspired by Nature
- Paper: Almost Amethyst, Whisper White, Tea Party DSP
- Ink: Almost Amethyst, Certainly Celery, So Saffron
- Accessories: Stampin' Write Markers (So Saffron, Almost Amethyst, Certainly Celery, Going Gray), Key Tag Punch, Small Corner Rounder Punch, Sponge Daubers

Card Directions:

1. Base card or Layer 1: Take a piece of Almost Amethyst and cut to $4 \frac{1}{4} \times 5 \frac{1}{2}$
2. Layer 2: Cut Tea Party DSP to $4 \frac{1}{8} \times 5 \frac{3}{8}$
3. Layer 3: Cut Almost Amethyst to $2 \frac{1}{8} \times 4 \frac{1}{8}$
4. Layer 4: Take Tea Party DSP (striped pattern) and cut to $2 \times 4 \frac{1}{8}$. Adhere to layer 3.
5. Layer 5: Cut Almost Amethyst card stock to $3 \frac{1}{2} \times 5 \frac{1}{8}$.
6. Layer 6: Cut Whisper White card stock to $3 \frac{3}{8} \times 5 \frac{1}{4}$
7. Color image with Almost Amethyst, So Saffron and Certainly Celery Stampin' Write Markers.
8. Don't forget to huff on stamp before stamping onto the Whisper White card stock.
9. Carefully draw lines with the Going Gray marker at equal intervals across your page, skipping over the image.
10. Turn your cardstock 90 degrees and draw lines with a pen at equal intervals, creating a grid which your images seem to float upon.
11. For interest, color a few of your squares in colors that coordinate with the rest of your project.
12. Adhere Layers 5 & 6
13. Stamp sentiment on Whisper White card stock and punch out with Key Tag Punch. Adhere to a piece of Almost Amethyst card stock. Carefully cut around the card stock so that there is a $\frac{1}{8}$ inch border.
14. Adhere sentiment to the main image as shown in picture.
15. Adhere all the layers together as shown in picture
