- Stamp Set: Winter Post
- Paper: Naturals Ivory, Real Red, Old Olive, Merry Moments Designer Series Paper
- Ink: Real Red Craft Ink
- Accessories: Designer Label Punch, Large Oval Punch, Scallop Oval Punch, Round Tab Punch, Circle Scissors Plus, Big Shot, Scallop Circle #2 Bigz Die, Gold Elastic Cord, Tombow Multi Purpose Adhesive, Stick Strip, Very Vanilla Grosgrain Ribbon, Real Red Grosgrain Ribbon, Mini Glue Dots, Bone Folder

### Card Sizes:

- Layer 1 or Base Card: Merry Moments DSP (4" x 8")
- Layer 2: Real Red (4"x4")
- Layer 3: Old Olive or Naturals Ivory (5" x 5") (need 2)
- Scrap of Naturals Ivory for Stamp "Do not open....."
- Half sheet of Naturals Ivory to feed through printer

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### Card Directions:



1. Layer 1: Take 4" x 8" and fold in half using a bone folder for a sharp crease



2. Punch top of square as shown in photo.



3. Add sticky tape to sides



4. Measure ribbon to determine how much to use



5. Add glue dots to end of ribbon. Adhere to just inside half circle.



6. Remove sticky tape cover and secure on both sides of DSP pocket. Wrap ribbon around DSP

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7. Wrap ribbon around and secure to inside of half circle (see photo).



8. Wrap another piece of ribbon (approx 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ ") around and secure with glue dots.



9. Add bow




10. I stamped several images on a piece of Naturals Ivory card stock and then punched out as needed using the Designer Label Punch

11. Adhere to top of bow with glue dots. Set Aside




12. Run Real Red card stock through Big Shot using the #2 Scallop Circle Die



13. Using the circle plus set at 3", cut two circles.


14. I add tape to all four corners of the cardstock to secure to glass mat so that it doesn't move around

15. After I cut two circles, I cut one of them in half to form the lower half of the pouch for the "money".




16. I add the adhesive to the lower part of the half circle.

17. You can see how it comes together.




18. Add adhesive to back of old olive card stock

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19. Adhere the two layers together


20. I typed out the names using the MDS and then punched them out as needed using the Oval punch





22. Adhere as shown in photo

23. Take a scrap of Old Olive card stock and punch out using the Round Tab Punch. This will be the top of the ornament.



24. Tie the Gold Elastic and add as shown in photo. Add the adhesive.

25. Adhere to top of ornament as shown in photo.

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26. Whew you're done! No really it was that bad. I just had to include a lot of extra pictures because I didn't know how to describe it without the pictures.
