



Stamping by Rachel Project Sheet



Stamp Set: Spring Song (115074)

Paper: Vellum Card Stock (101856), Whisper White Card Stock (100730), Pretty in Pink Card Stock (100459), Certainly Celery Card Stock (105125), Tea Party DSP (113992)

Ink: Basic Black Craft Ink Pad (102995)

Accessories: Pretty in Pink Stampin' Write Marker (100045), Certainly Celery Stampin' Write Marker (105106), Soft Subltes Brads (106954), Pretty in Pink ¼" Grosgrain Ribbon (109032), Clear Emboss Powder (109130), Photo Corners Punch (109042), Heat Tool

(100005), Vintage Wallpaper Textured Impressions Embossing Folder (120175), Big Shot Die Cut Machine (113439), Bone Folder (102300)

Directions:

1. Stamp image on vellum card stock using Basic Black Craft Ink Pad. Add Clear Embossing Powder and set with Heat Gun. Color in image with Stampin' Write Markers
2. Layer 1 (base card). Cut Certainly Celery card stock to 5 ½" x 11". Fold in half using a bone folder for a sharp crease.
3. Layer 3. Cut Pretty in Pink card stock to 5 ¼" x 4".
4. Layer 4. Cut Tea Party DSP to 5 x 3 ¾" and feed through Big Shot using the Vintage Wallpaper Embossing Folder
5. Tie Pretty in Pink Ribbon as shown in photo
6. Cut Pretty in Pink card stock to 3 ¾" x 3 ¼".
7. Cut Whisper White card stock to 3 ½" x 3". Cut vellum card stock (with image) to 3 ½" x 3" and layer Whisper White card stock under the vellum card stock. Adhere with glue dots under the hummingbird and flowers. Adhere at upper right corner and lower left corner (where you are going to place the photo corners).
8. Punch out photo corners using a scrap piece of Tea Party DSP. Adhere to upper right and lower left corners. Add brads on opposite sides.
9. Assemble as shown in photo
