



Step 1



Cut your card-stock to 4 1/4 X 5 1/2. Fold at TOP

Using 1 3/8 circle punch by SU! punch a 1/2 circle in top fold.

Step 2



Using same hole punch-Punch the bottom sides for the leg holes.

See how it is about a 3/4 of the punch? That will ensure it is even. There is a “pie graph” in the punch that shows you where 1/2 and a 1/4 of the circle is. Use that as your guide. Clear as mud? Use my photo.

Step 3



Snip the sharp corners at the bottom, straight.

Then score it from the back.

Step 4/5



Holding the card horizontally (fold to the left) Place fold at 1 3/4 mark. Cut in a 1/2 inch. This makes the sleeves.

Do that on both sides.

Then use your ruler, and a sharp hobby blade-an go from corner of leg, to end cut of sleeve, and cut. (this is the easiest way unless you are a PRO with your paper cutter)

This is what it should look like



Step 6/7



Now you are ready for the trim! This is optional, but oh so cute.

Punch  $\frac{1}{2}$  a  $1 \frac{3}{8}$  circle into desired card-stock. Then punch the scallop. You will need 3 of them.

Now put them on your card. Don't worry about excess because you trim it away on the leg holes.

This is what you have before trimming.



Now you just stamp as desired!

You can add snaps or buttons
