Supplies I used:

- One 7" x 11" piece of card stock
- Scor-Pal or other scoring tool
- Scissor Snips
- Adhesive (Sticky Strip)
- Additional card stock and embellishments to decorate your box

I used the pizza box tutorial from Splitcoast Stampers. Here's the tutorial <u>Pizza Box Tutorial</u> but tailored it to fit the Top Note Die Cut. I've provided the instructions for making the 5" x 4" box vs the 4" x 4" in the Splitcoast Tutorial.




Step 1:

With the short side of the 7" x 11" card stock at the top of the scoring tool, score at 1" and 6" $^{\prime\prime}$



Step 2:

Turn card stock and on the 11" side of the card stock, score at 1", 5", 6" and 10"




Step 3:


Following the scored lines along the 11" side, use scissors to cut flaps. Begin cut on outer edge of paper and stop at the perpendicular scored line as shown.



Step 4: Fold on all scored lines to give them a sharp crease.



Step 5:
Use Sticky Strip on all flaps.



Step 6:
Adhere flaps to inside of box





Step 5:

Decorate and Fill Box as desired.
