

Slimline Card



A slimline card is a long and narrow card made to fit in a regular #10 business envelope, which measures approximately 4 1/8" x 9 1/2". This type of card is much longer and narrower than the most common size of handmade card, which measures 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" and fits in an A2 size envelope. A slimline card measure 3 1/2" x 8 1/2".



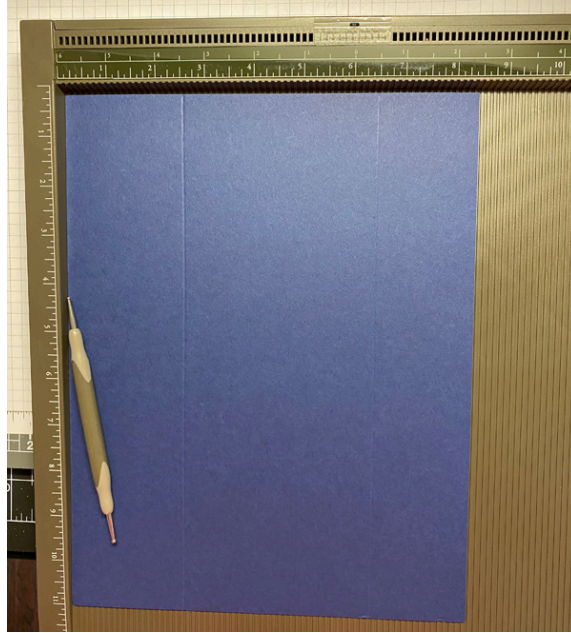
Card Measurements:

- Whisper White Card Stock: 7 1/2" x 2 7/8"
- Gold Foil Sheet: 7 3/4" x 3"
- Wrapped in Plaid Designer Series Paper: 8 1/4" x 3 1/4"
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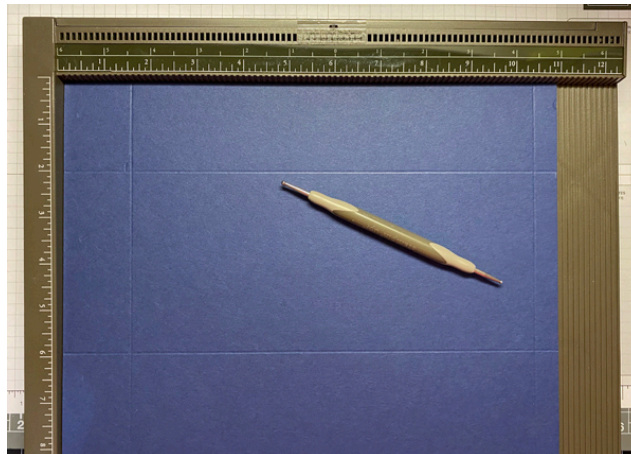
How To Make A Slimline Card Envelope

Scoring the Envelope

To make a slimline card envelope, begin with a piece of 8 1/2" x 11" cardstock. With the cardstock laying vertically, create a score line at 2 1/2" and 6 1/2".

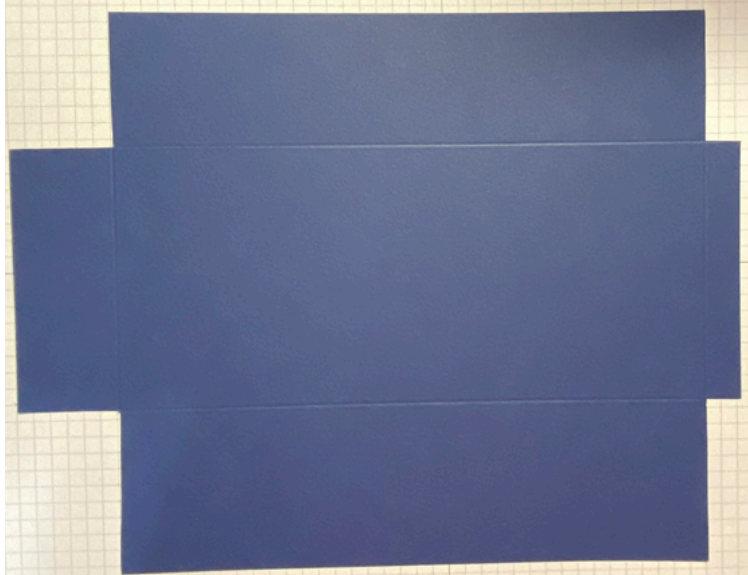


Turn the cardstock horizontally and score it at 1 1/2" and 10 1/2".

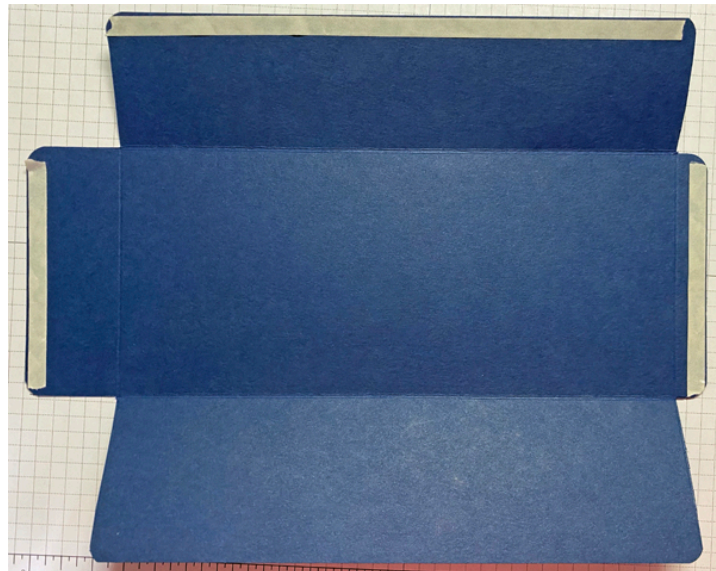


Trimming the Envelope

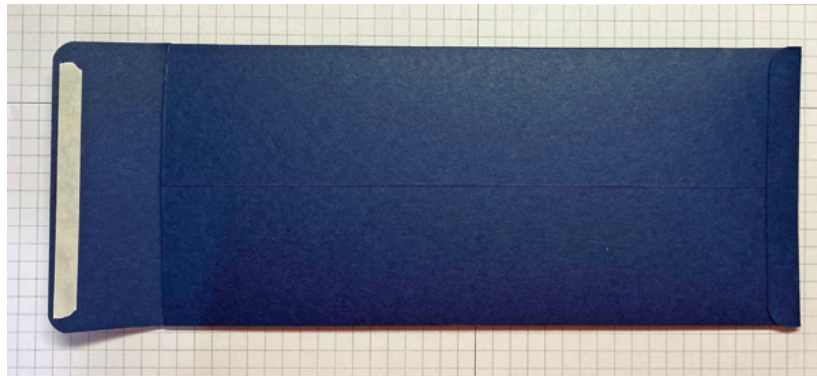
Trim each of the corners out using scissors.



Fold the long flaps inward and use a corner rounder to round the remaining four corners. Attach strong adhesive such as Tear and Tape adhesive to the three flaps as shown.



Fold in the wider flap, then remove the paper backing from the narrower flap and fold it in to adhere it. Remove paper backing from the narrow flap, fold and adhere it.



Done! Now you have a pretty envelope for your lovely card. **Note:** I added a piece of matching DSP to the outside flap of the envelope though this is not necessary.
